**OBSERVATIONS:**

Commissioners viewed the stone walls that are to be reconstructed and stairs leading to the concrete slab to be expanded by 6 feet on an existing horizontal stone platform. They noted:

- a) that the work proposed in the application would impact neither the stones making up the sloping lake-shore bank nor a medium-size red maple located at the eastern end of the proposed expanded concrete slab;
- b) that there was no provision in the application to replace or modify the natural vegetative cover that protects from erosion the very steep, narrow strip of land between the road's edge and the stone wall at the back of the concrete slab.

Mr. Lleshi informed that all construction debris (largely concrete from the stairs to be replaced by granite steps and portions of the old concrete slab) will be removed daily as the work progresses and stored on the applicant's driveway prior to removal.
