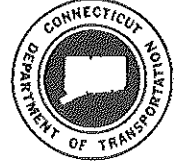

Subject: Scenic Road Application  
Route 109, Town of Washington

It is my pleasure to inform you that on March 9, 2017, Commissioner James Redeker approved the Scenic Road Advisory Committee's recommendation to designate a portion of Route 109 in the Town of Washington as a scenic road.

When the committee considers an application and performs a field review, it looks for continuity of scenic road qualities along the proposed segment. The committee found that the roadway section your town submitted possesses significant natural, cultural, scenic, and historic features along the borders, and therefore, has been approved as a scenic road:

- A 3.3 mile section of Route 109, from the intersection Route 47, northerly to the intersection with Woodcreek Road.

Much of Connecticut's rich and diverse landscape is experienced from the state's network of roads, and scenic road designations recognize and help preserve our most special corridors. The newly designated section of Route 109 is distinctive, and contributions to Connecticut's Scenic Roads.

Department personnel will install Scenic Road signing as soon as scheduling permits.

Thank you for taking the time to recommend this designation, and please accept my apologies for the length of time to complete the process.
