Washington, CT

For a small town in rural Connecticut, Washington has a big reputation for its arts and architecture. The Judy Black Memorial Park and Gardens is set in a once abandoned gas station and boasts lovely landscaping and revolving art exhibits; Bee Brook Park is a pop-up park featuring environmental art by notable muralists.

Every July, the Litchfield Jazz Festival takes place at venues around town and world-renowned modern dance company Pilobolus holds its Five Senses Festival. In September, Gilmore Girls fans take over—the town inspired the TV program's fictional Stars Hollow. Surrounded by colonial architecture, shop in unique boutiques and treat yourself to dinner (and a room, for a real spurge) at the historic, luxurious Mayflower Inn.

Revel in Small Town Charm in the Real Stars Hollow

Stars Hollow comes alive in Washington Depot, Connecticut, a.k.a. the town that inspired its quaint-yet-magical existence. Gilmore Girls creator Amy Sherman-Palladino was struck by the "fairy"-like feel of this off-the-grid village while staying at the Mayflower Inn & Spa, which fans will surely equate to the series'

own Independence Inn. "The inn was so beautiful," the program creator told <u>The Deseret News</u> in February 2001. "At the time I was there, it was beautiful, it was magical, and it was feeling of warmth and small-town camaraderie."

Now, tourists flock to Washington and its neighboring city of Kent each year for the <u>Gilmore Girls fan fest</u> to experience life through the eyes of Sookie, Luke and the rest of the residents of Stars Hollow. Those passing through in the off-season can get a feel for its charm at the <u>Washington Food Market</u>, which looks more than a little like Doose's (the convenience store in which Rory got her first kiss from Dean). As for Luke's diner? Try Marty's Cafe for a cup of coffee, black — just how Lorelai would order it.


Summer Escape to the Hills






