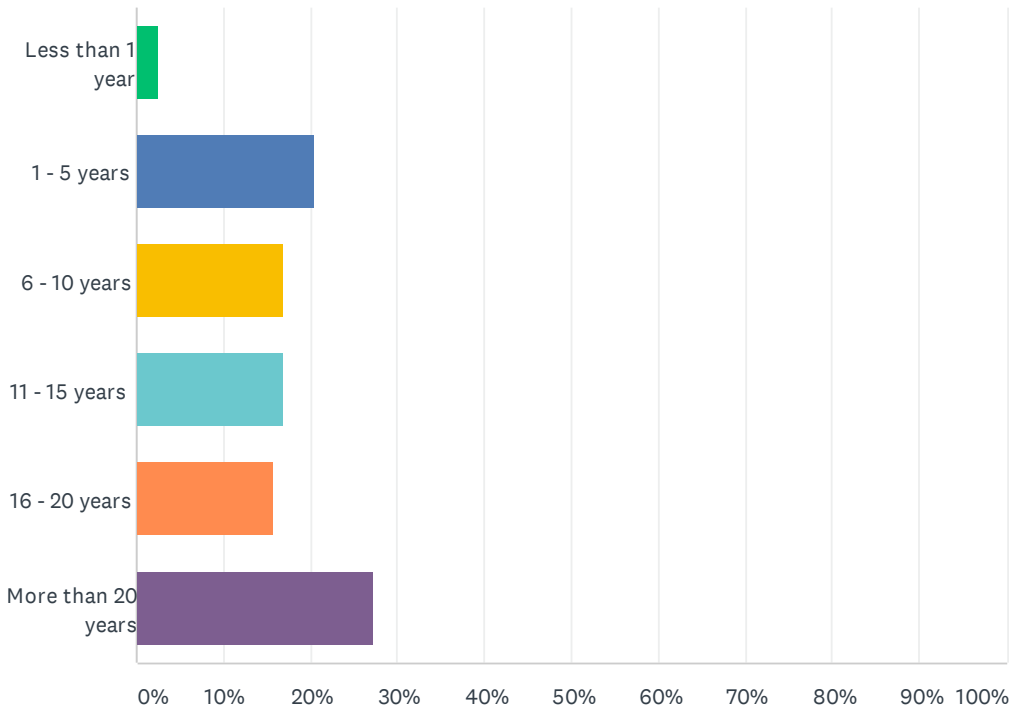

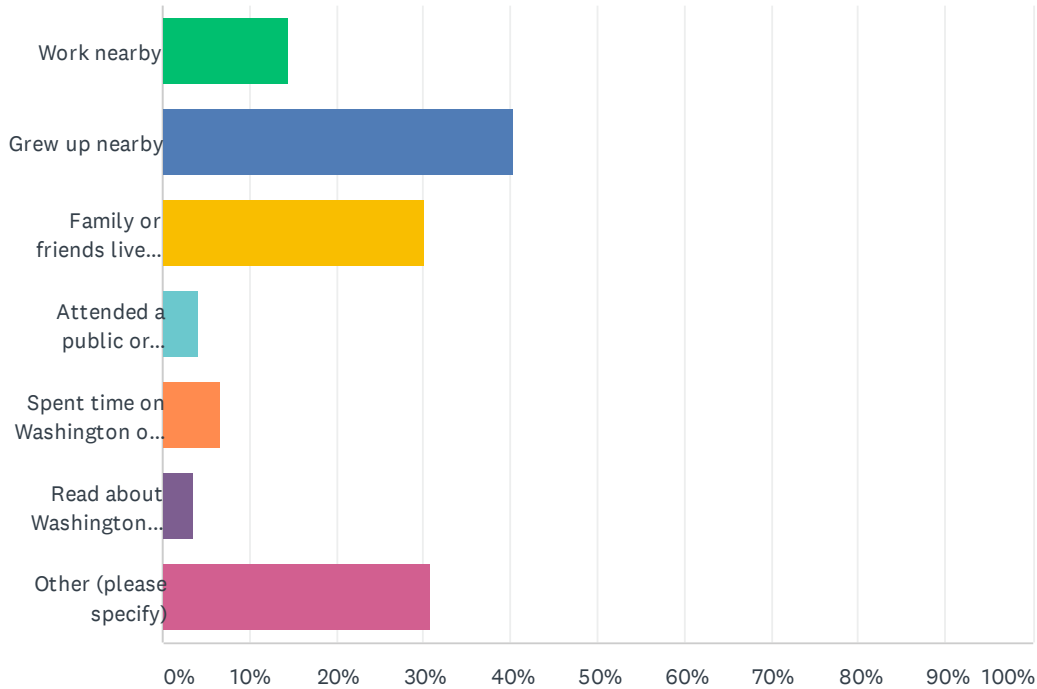

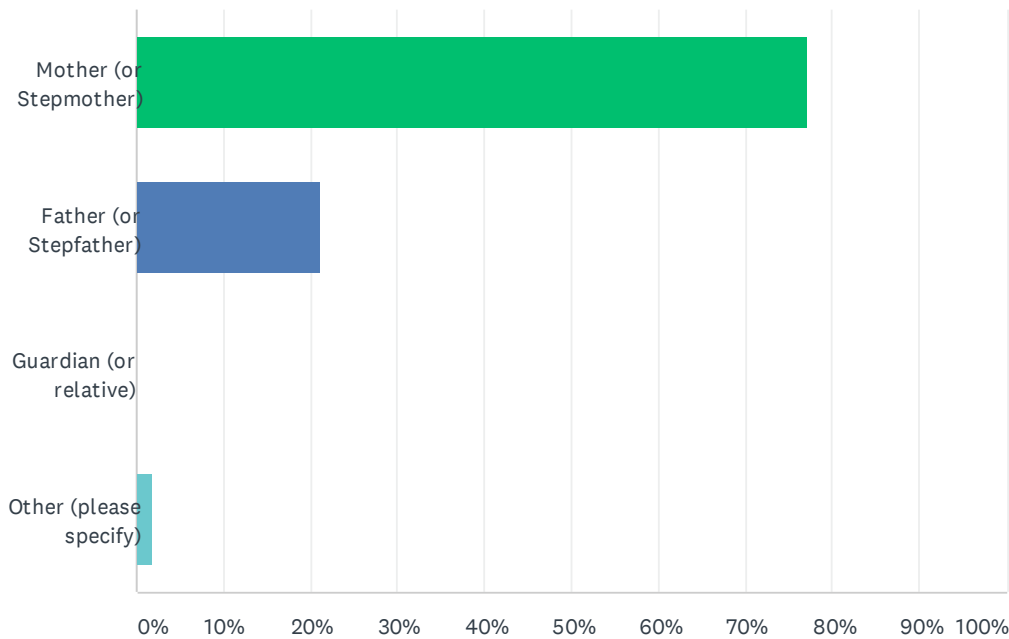

Q4 Which of the following best describes your role in the family?

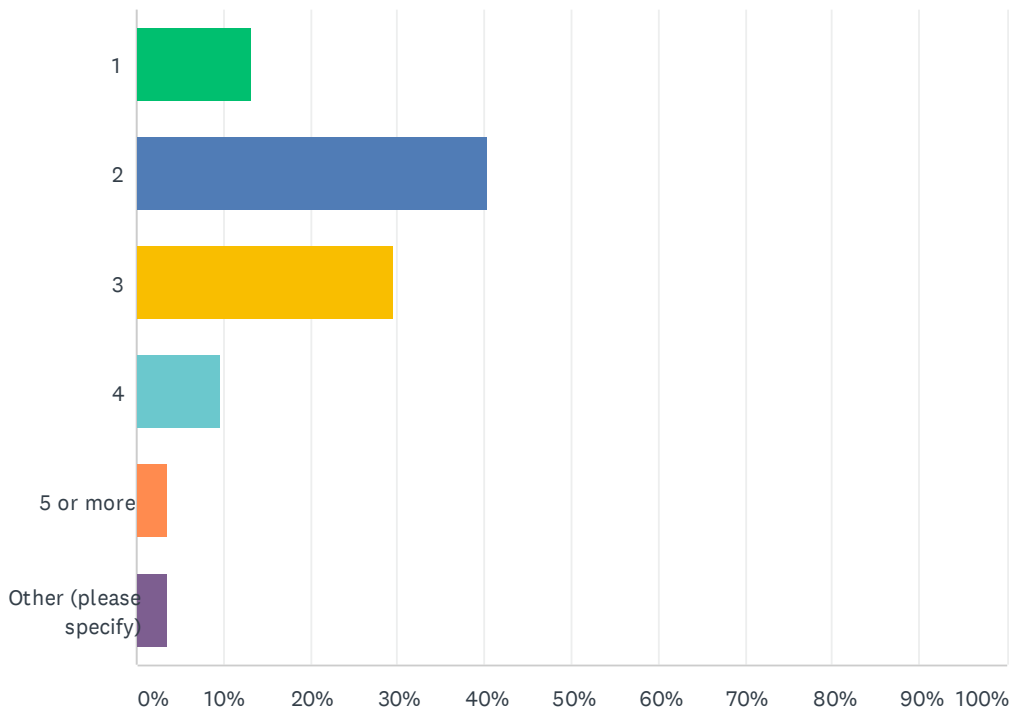

Q5 How many children have you raised in this area?

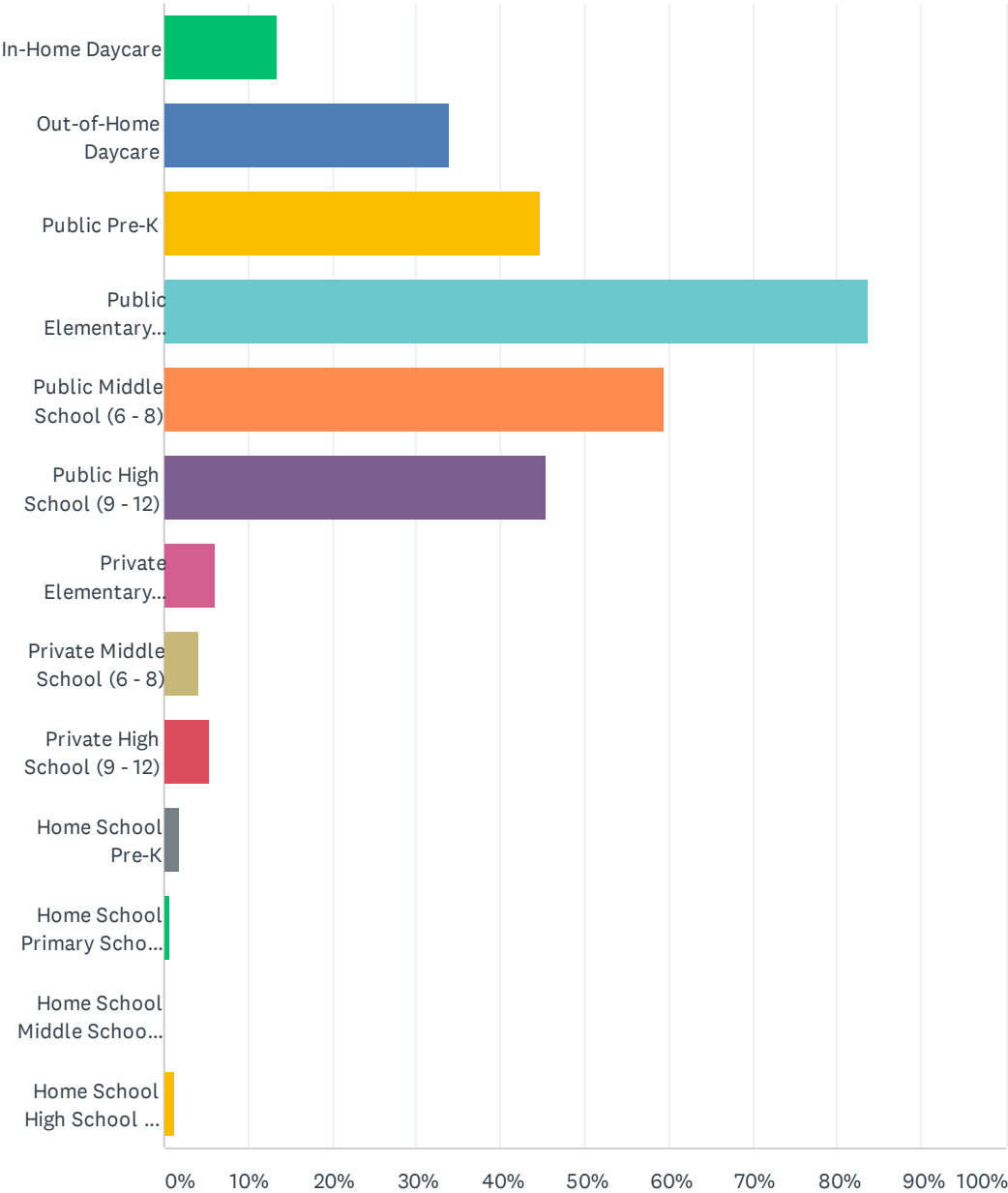

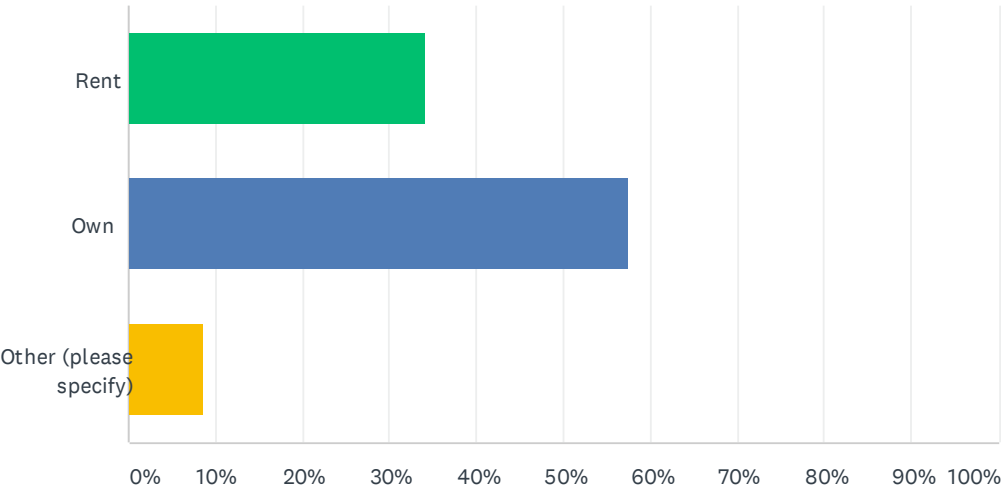

Q8 Did you rent or own your previous home?

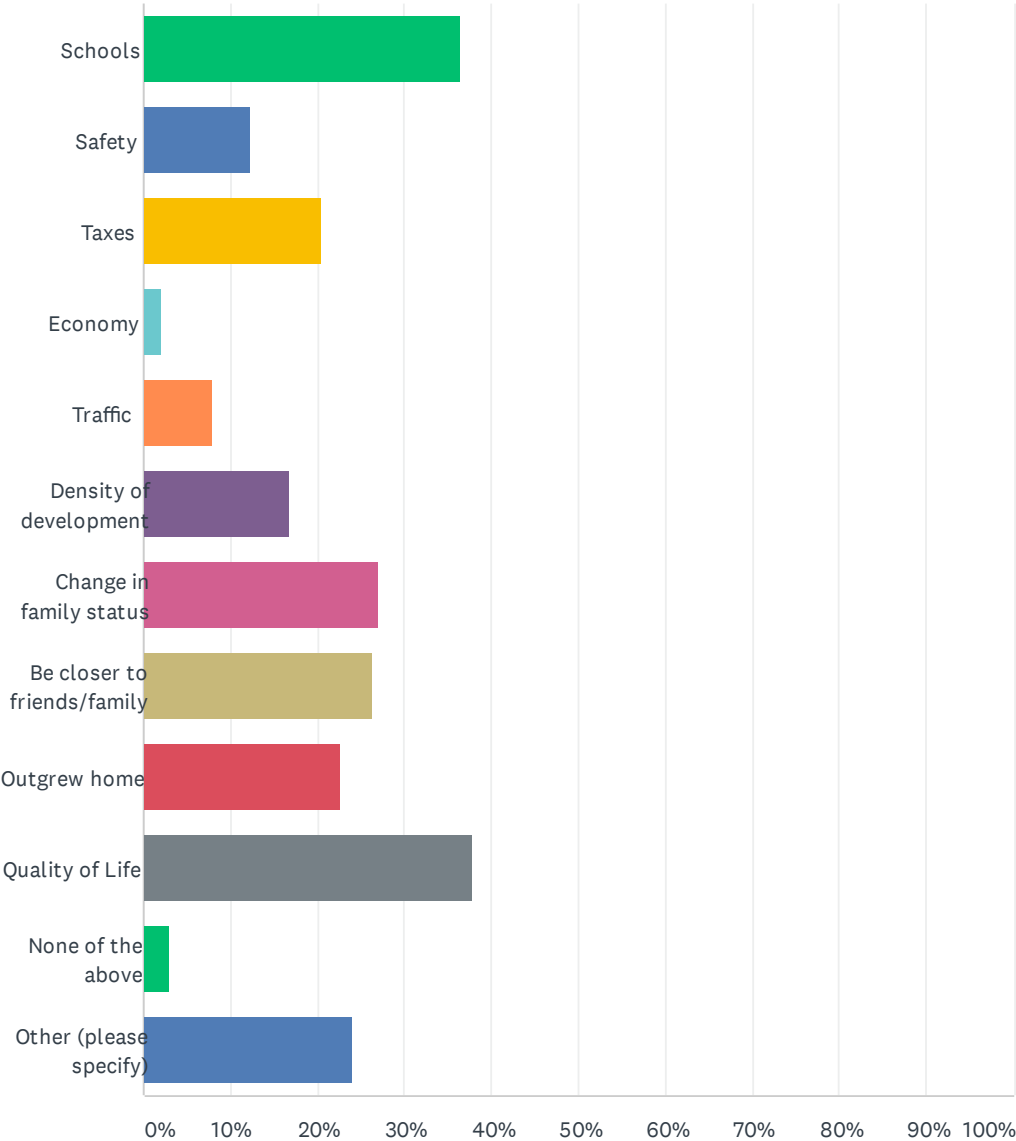

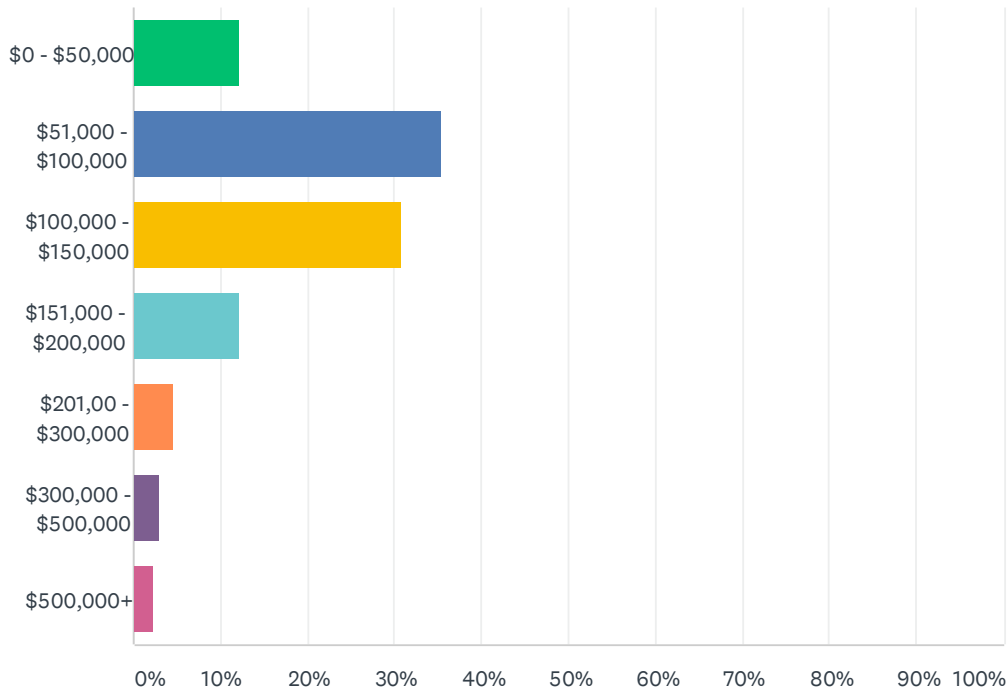

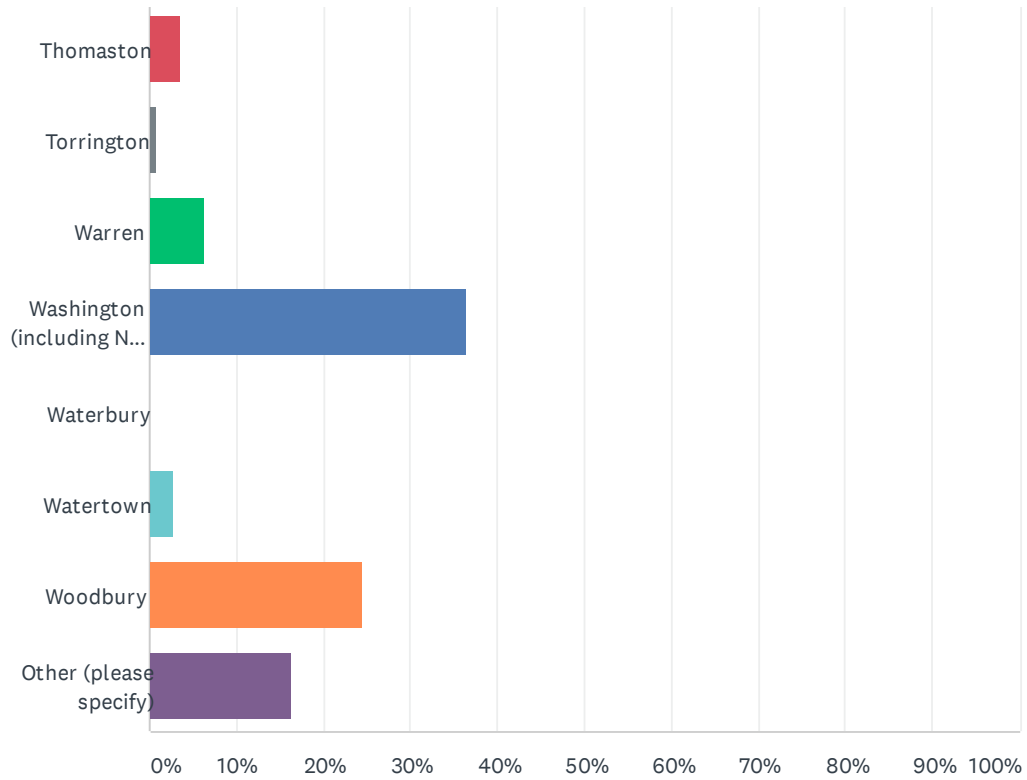

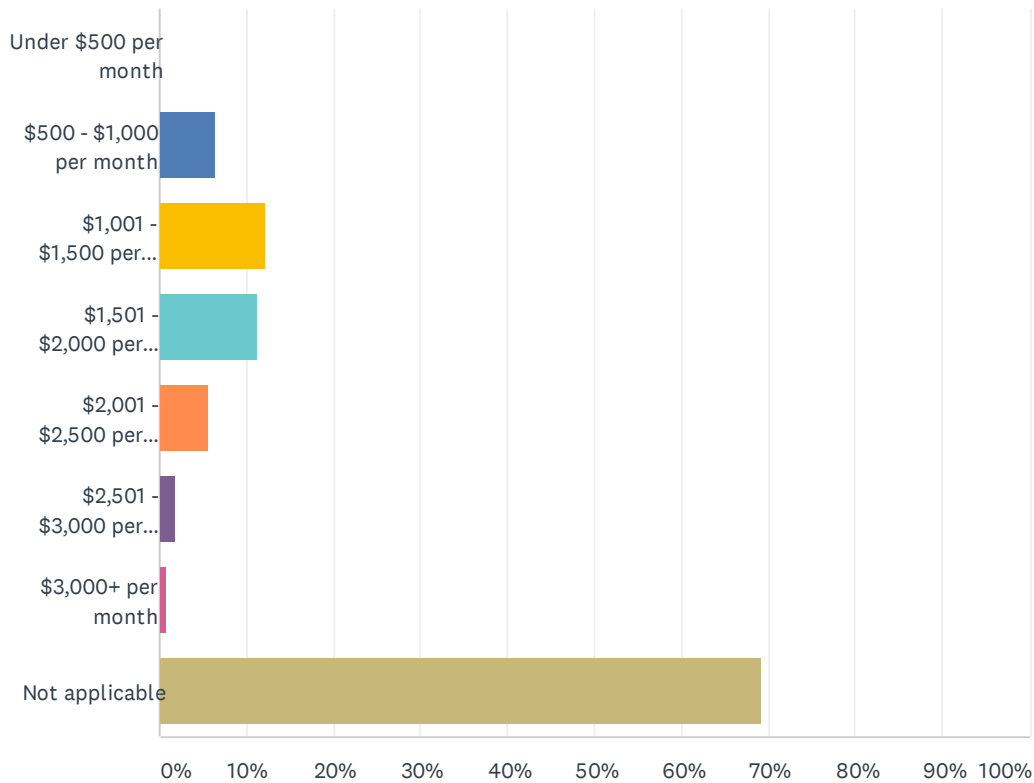

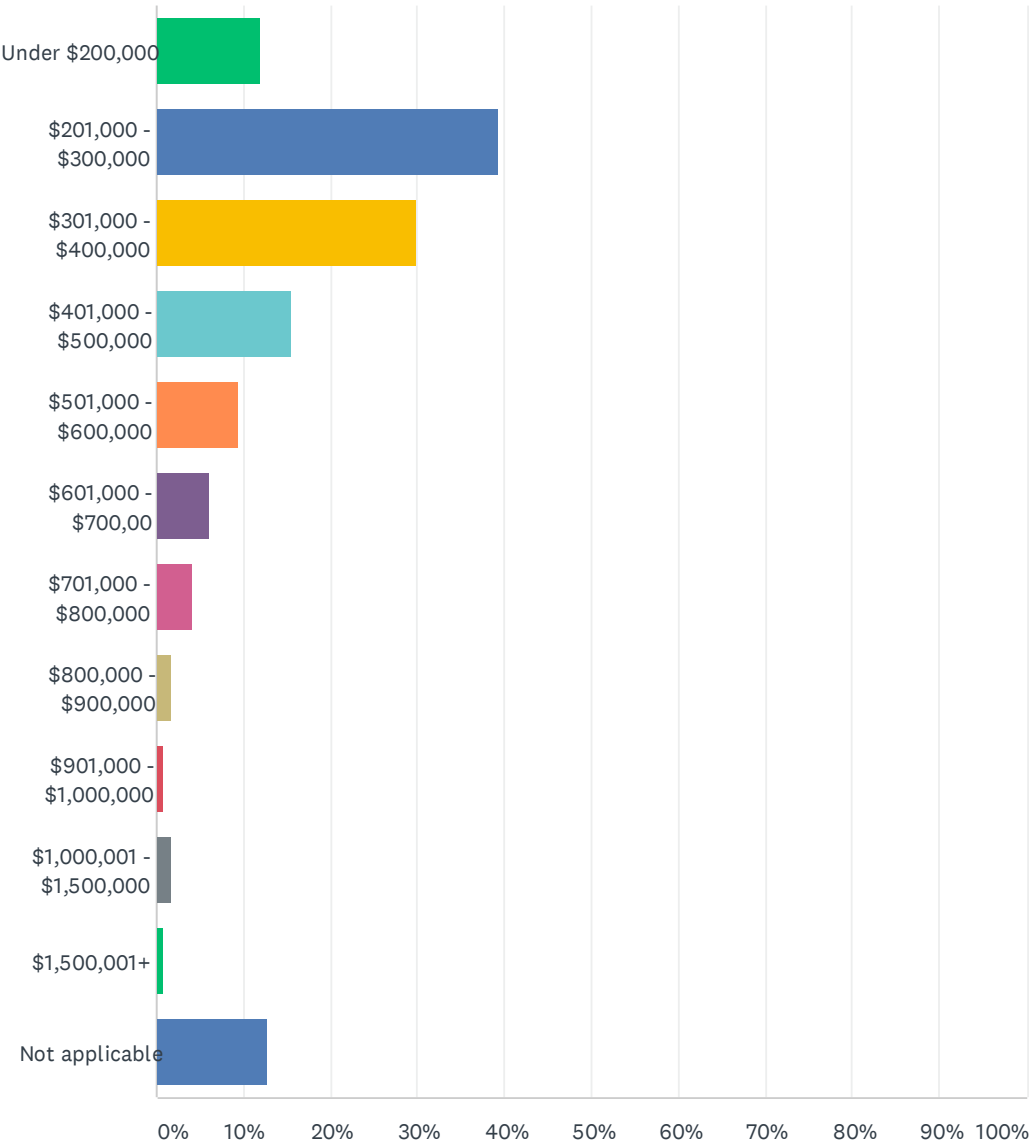

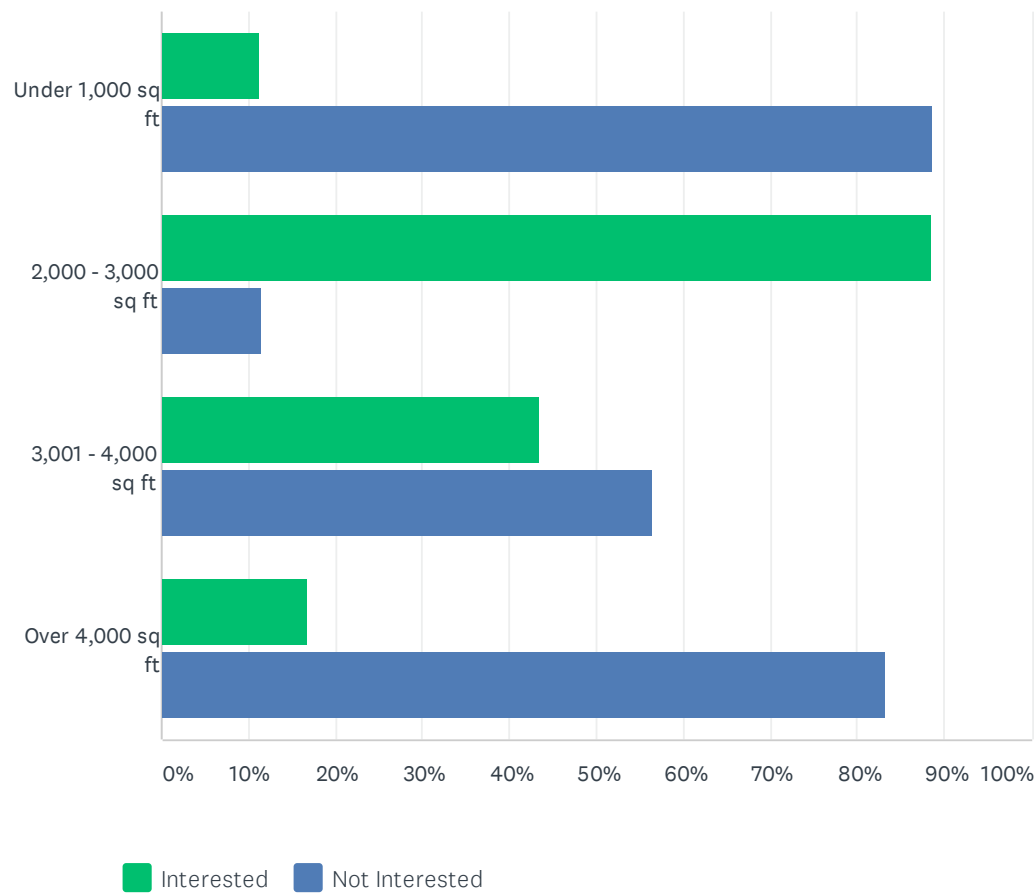

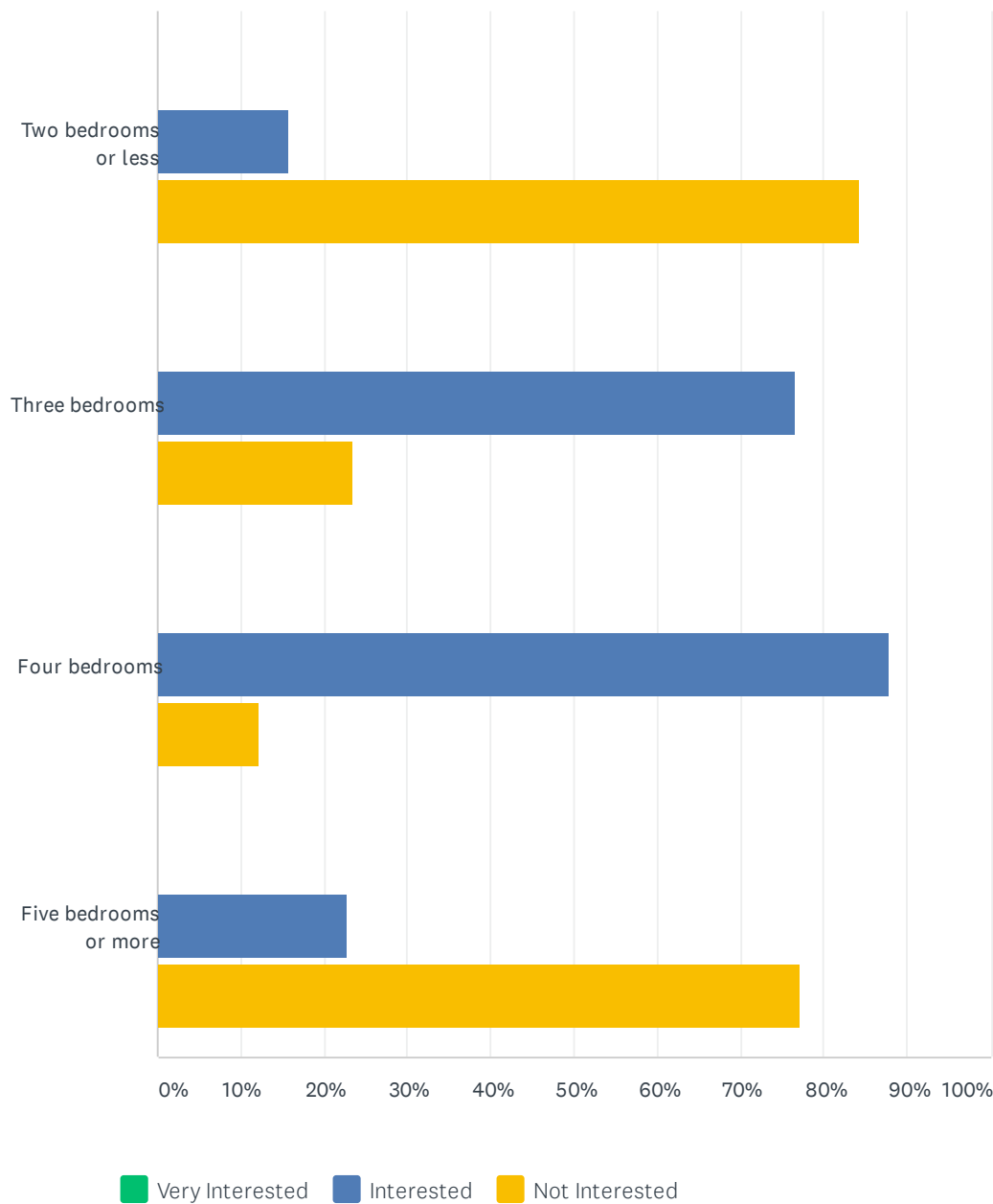

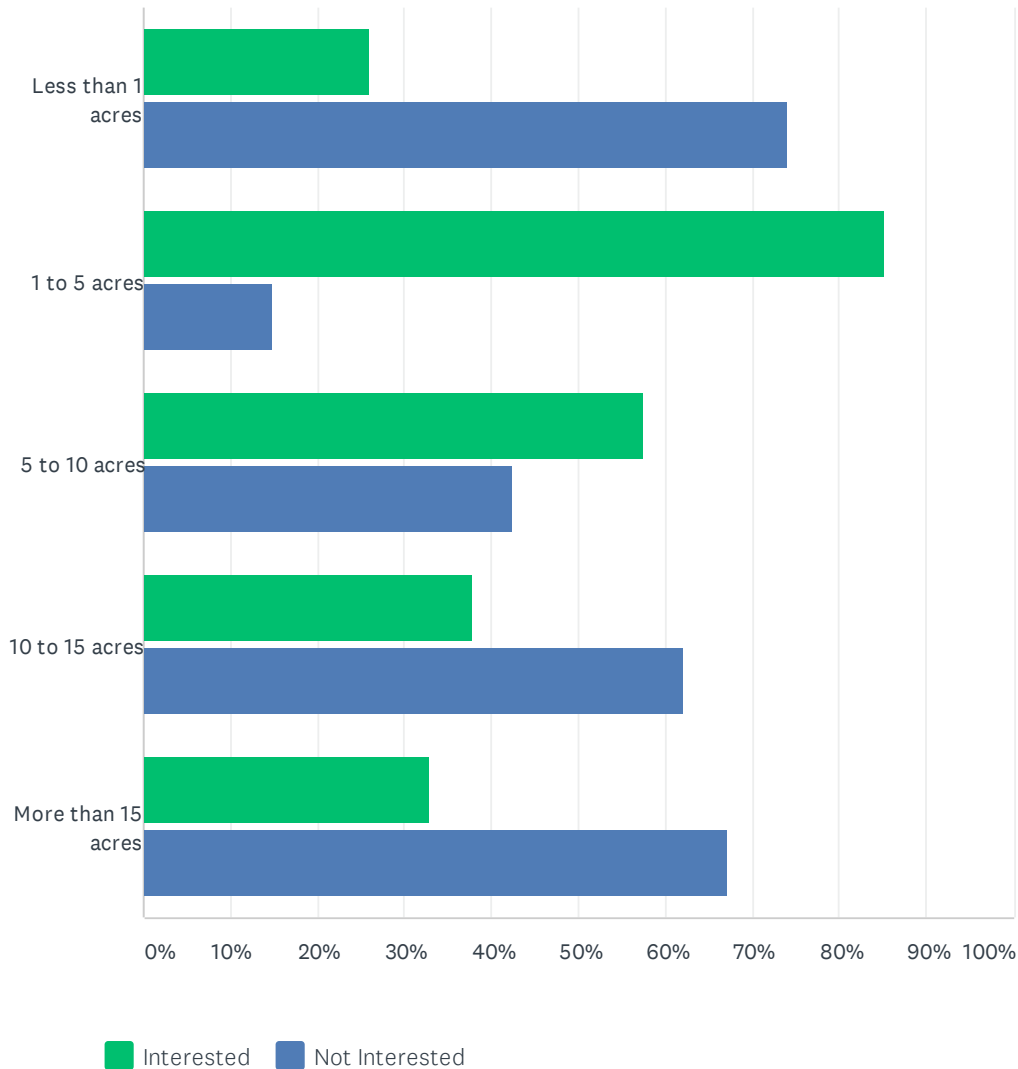

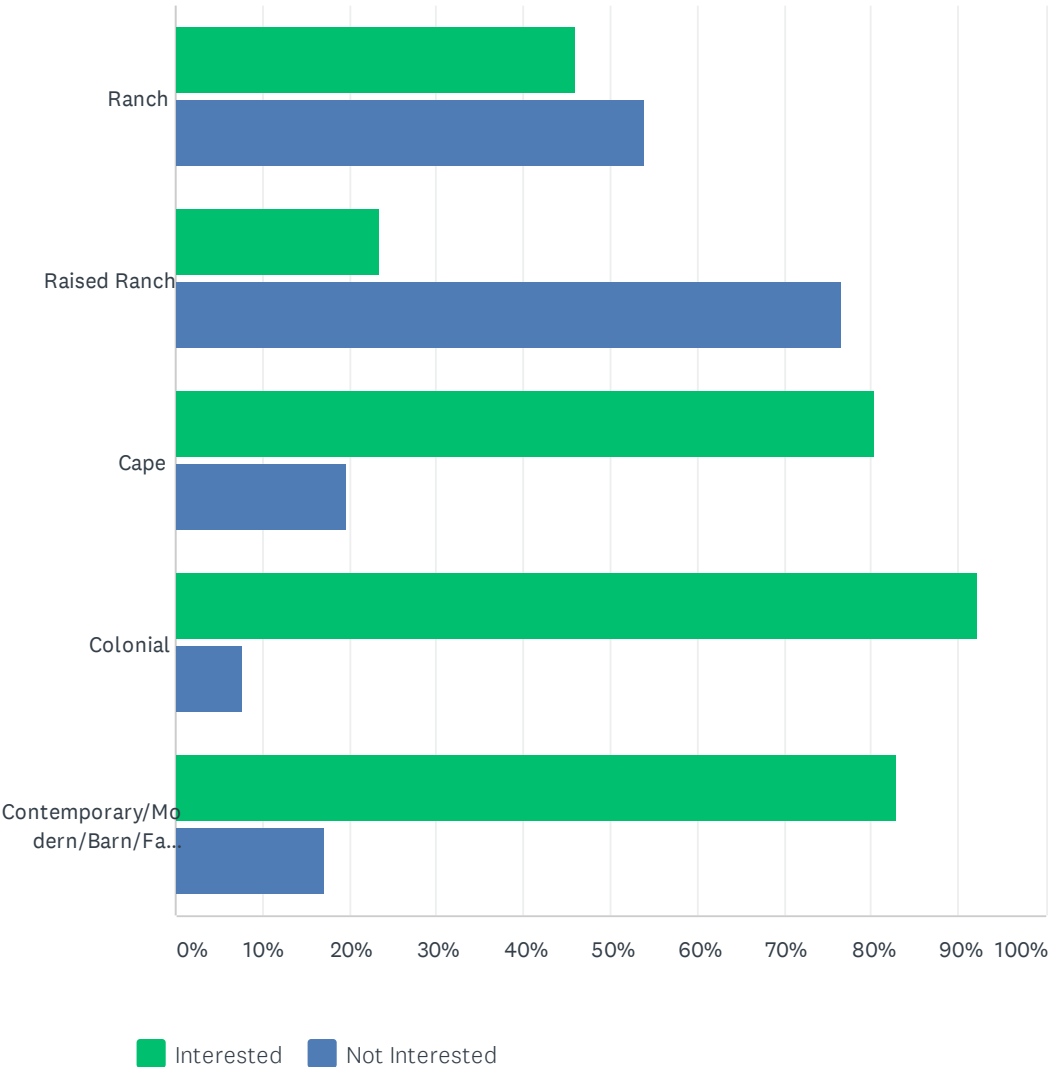

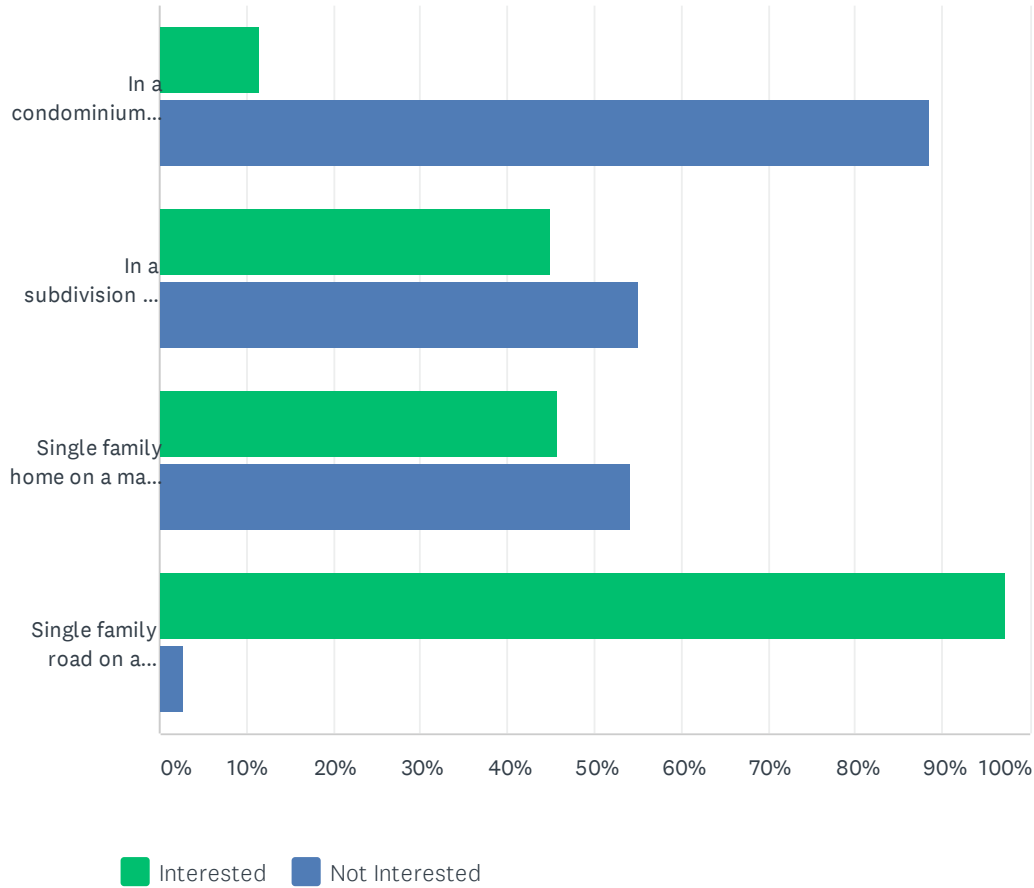

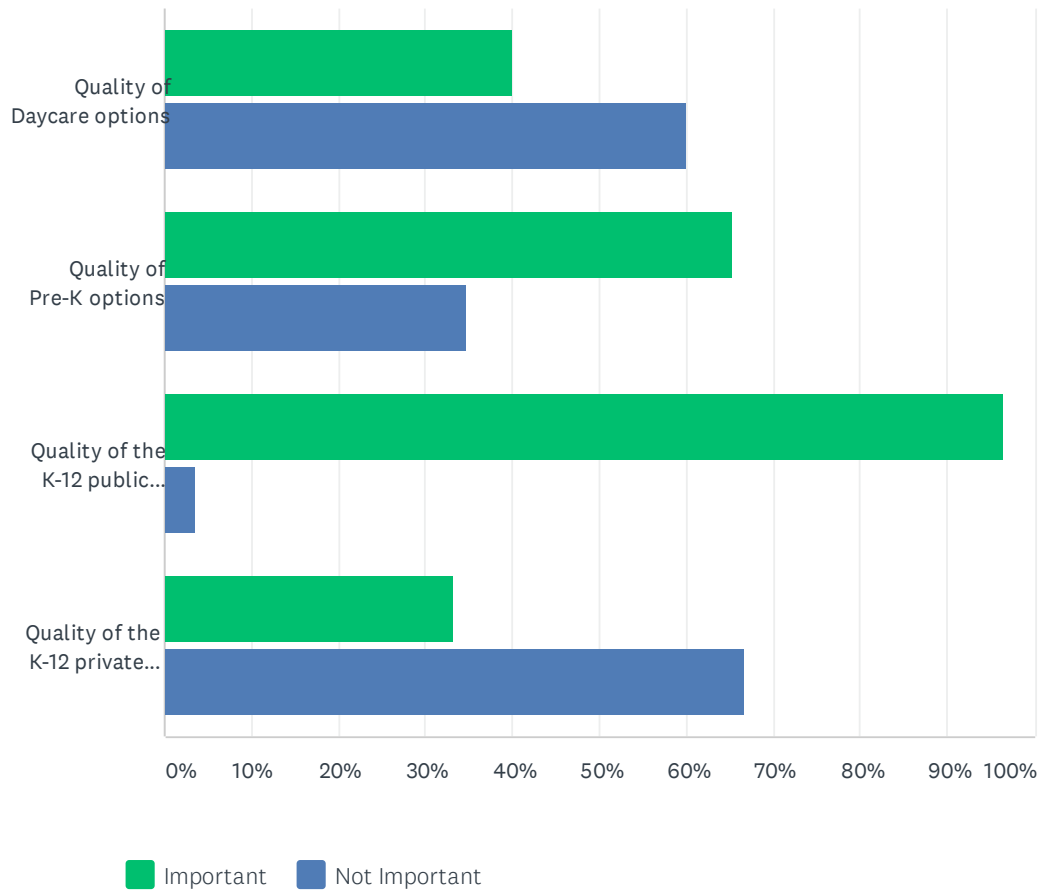

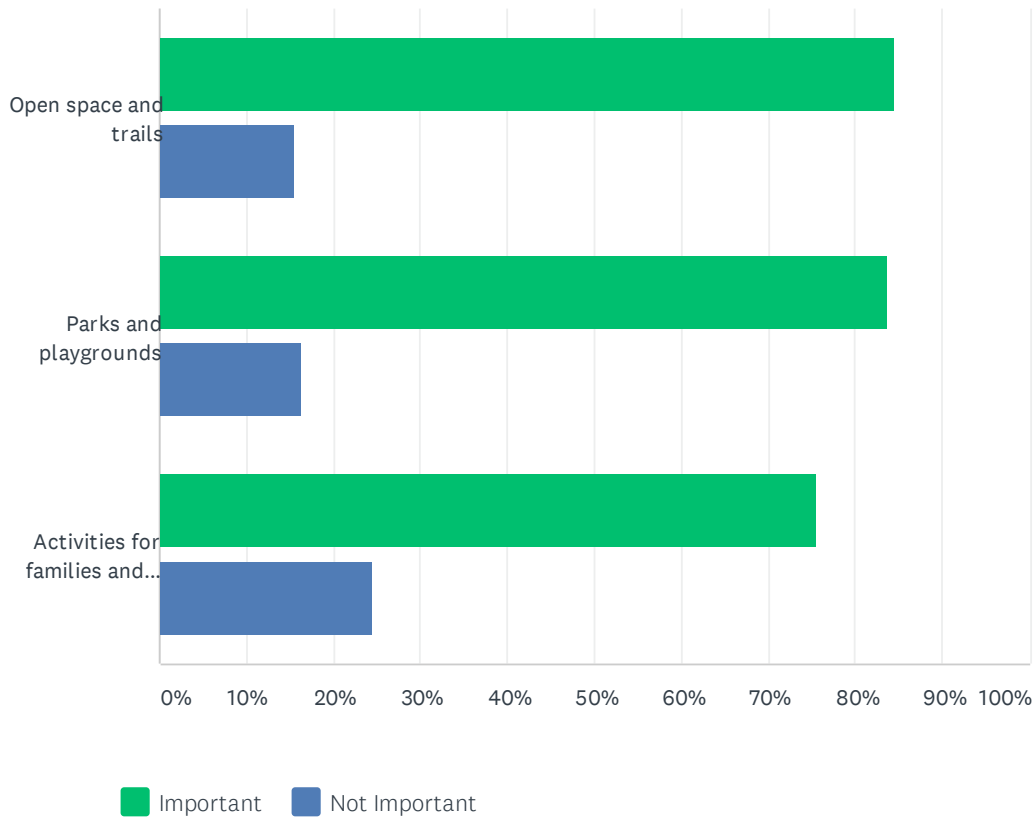

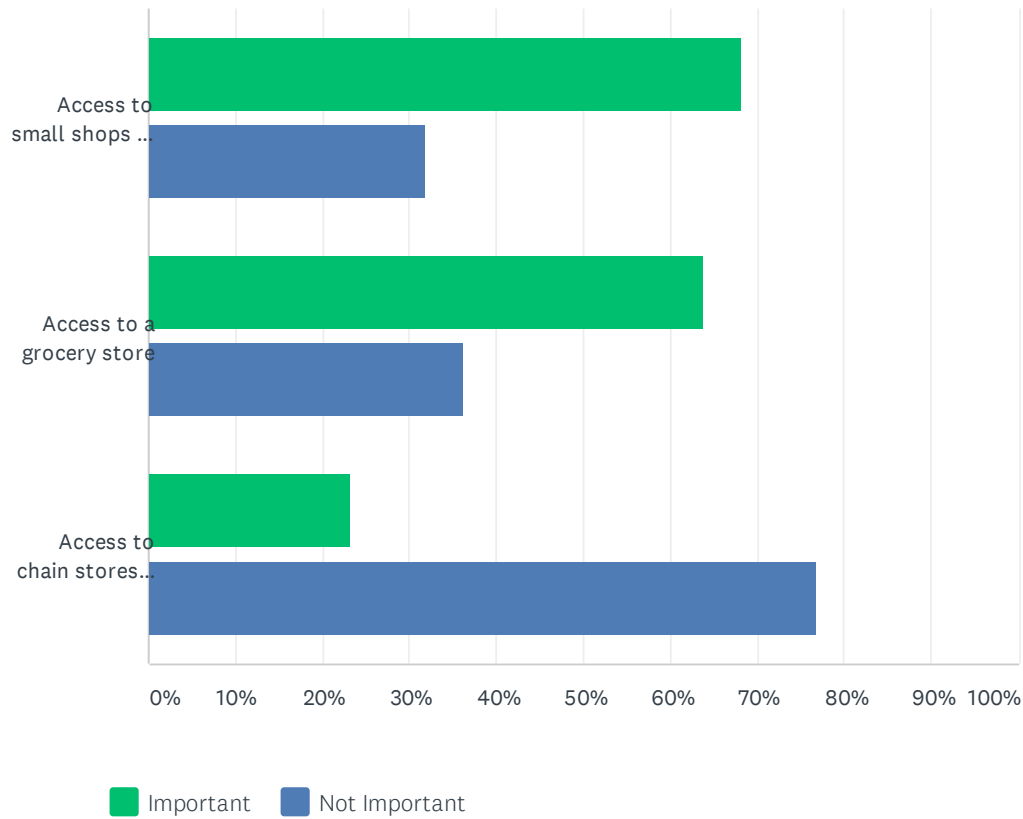

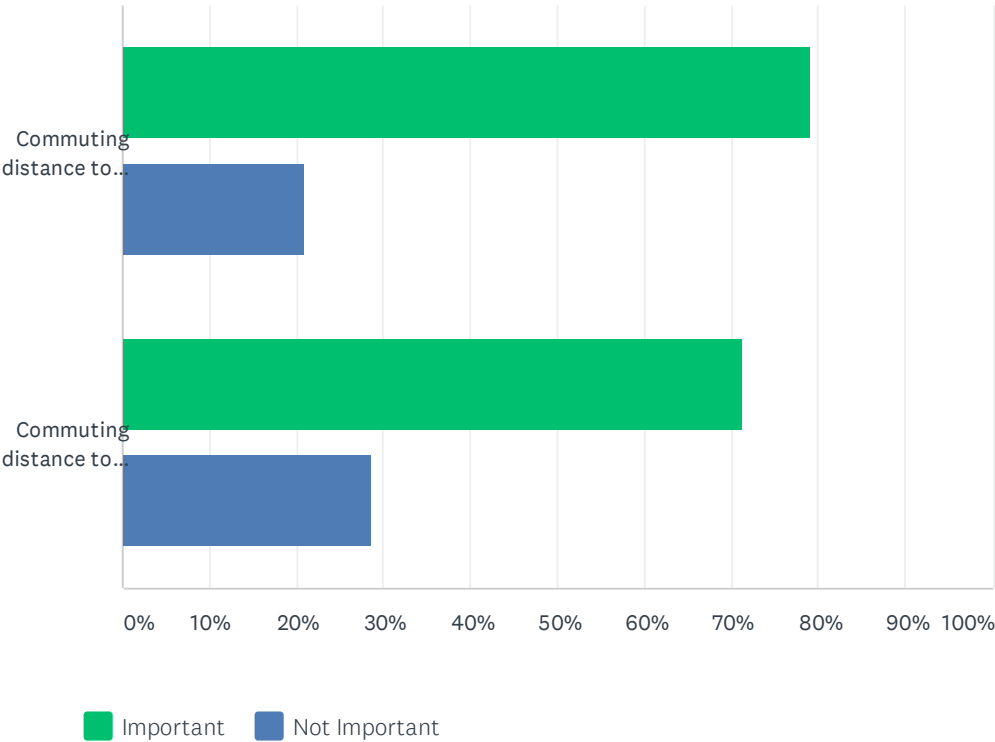

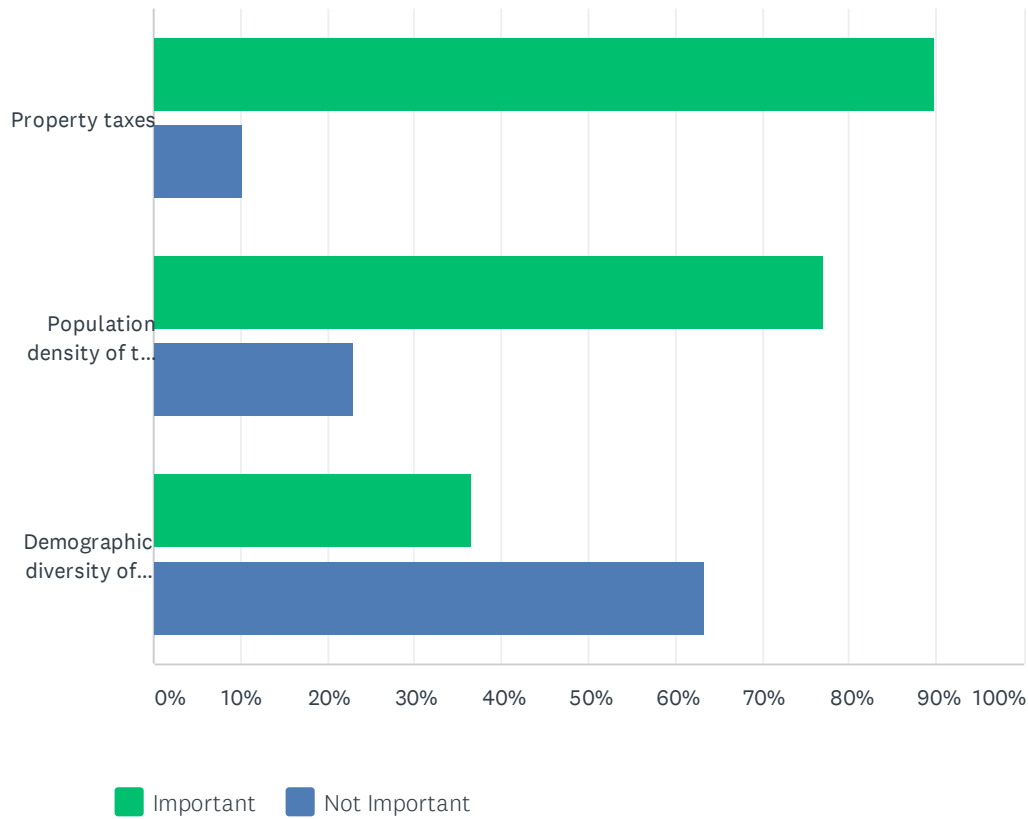

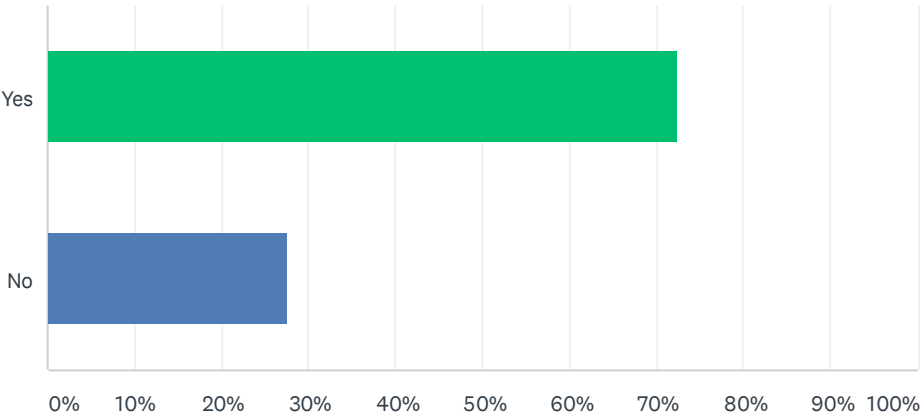

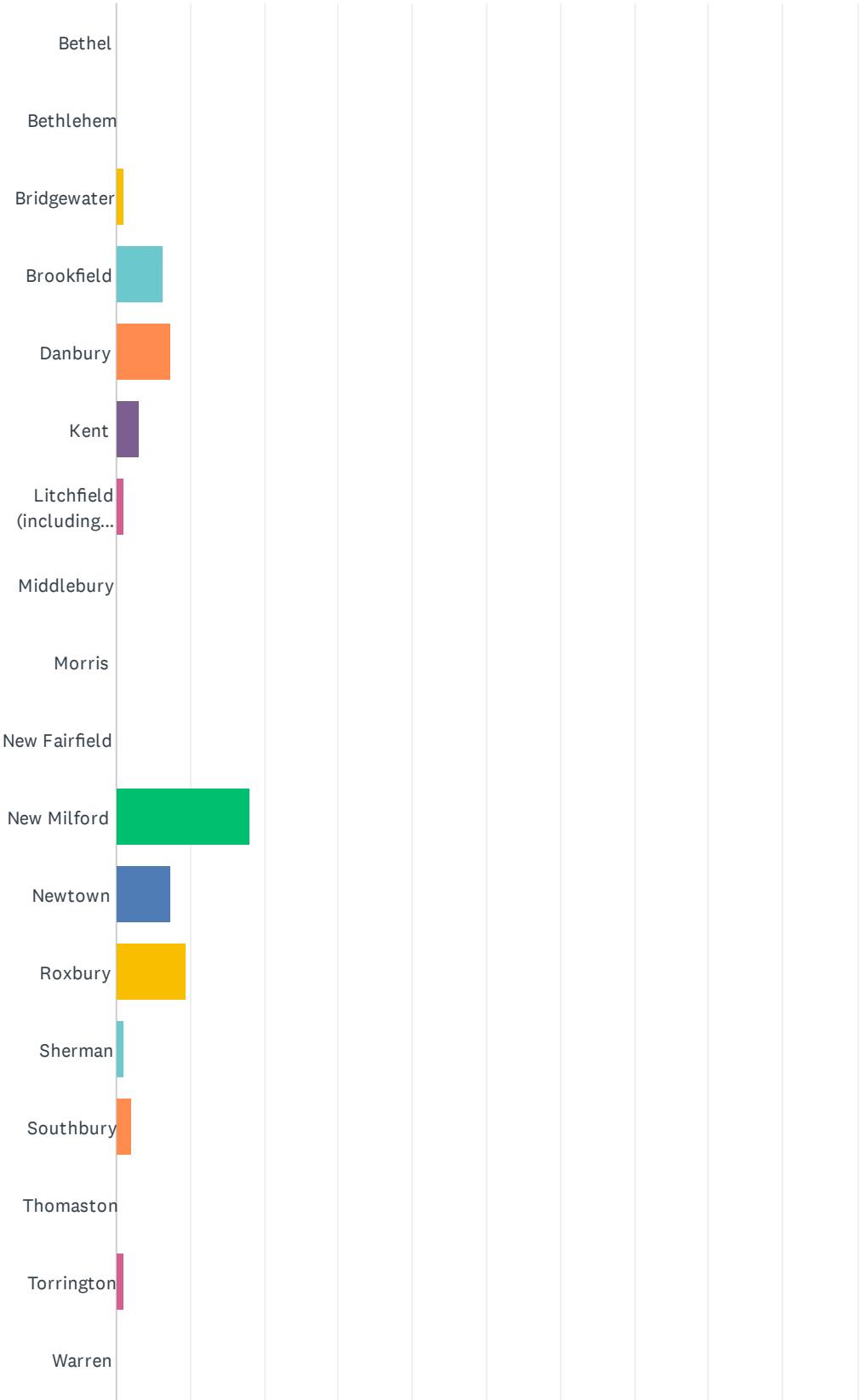

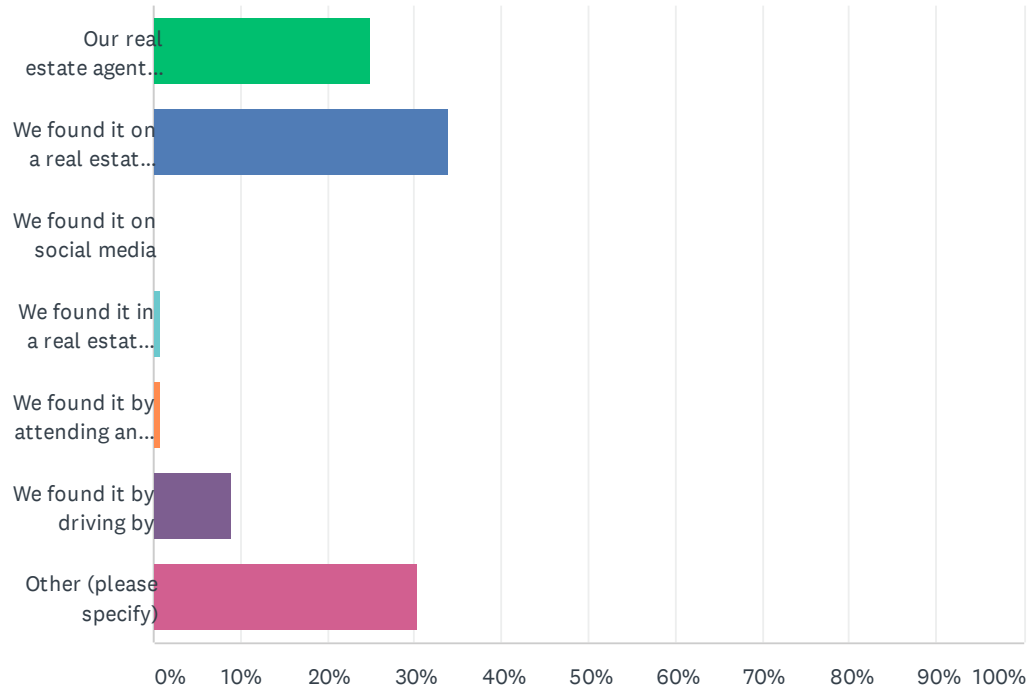

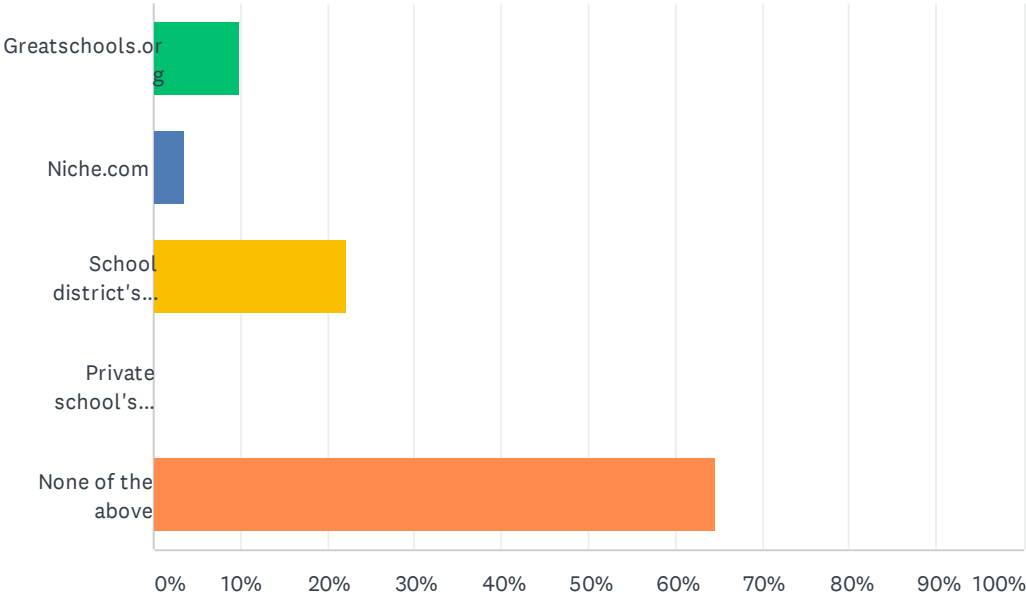

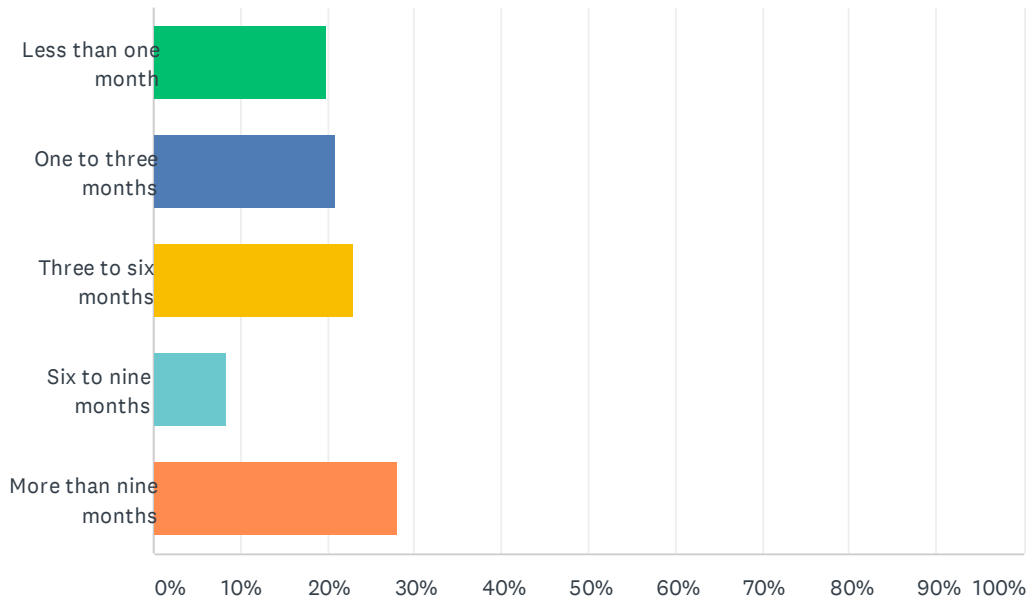

Q33 How long did the search take to find the home you purchased here?

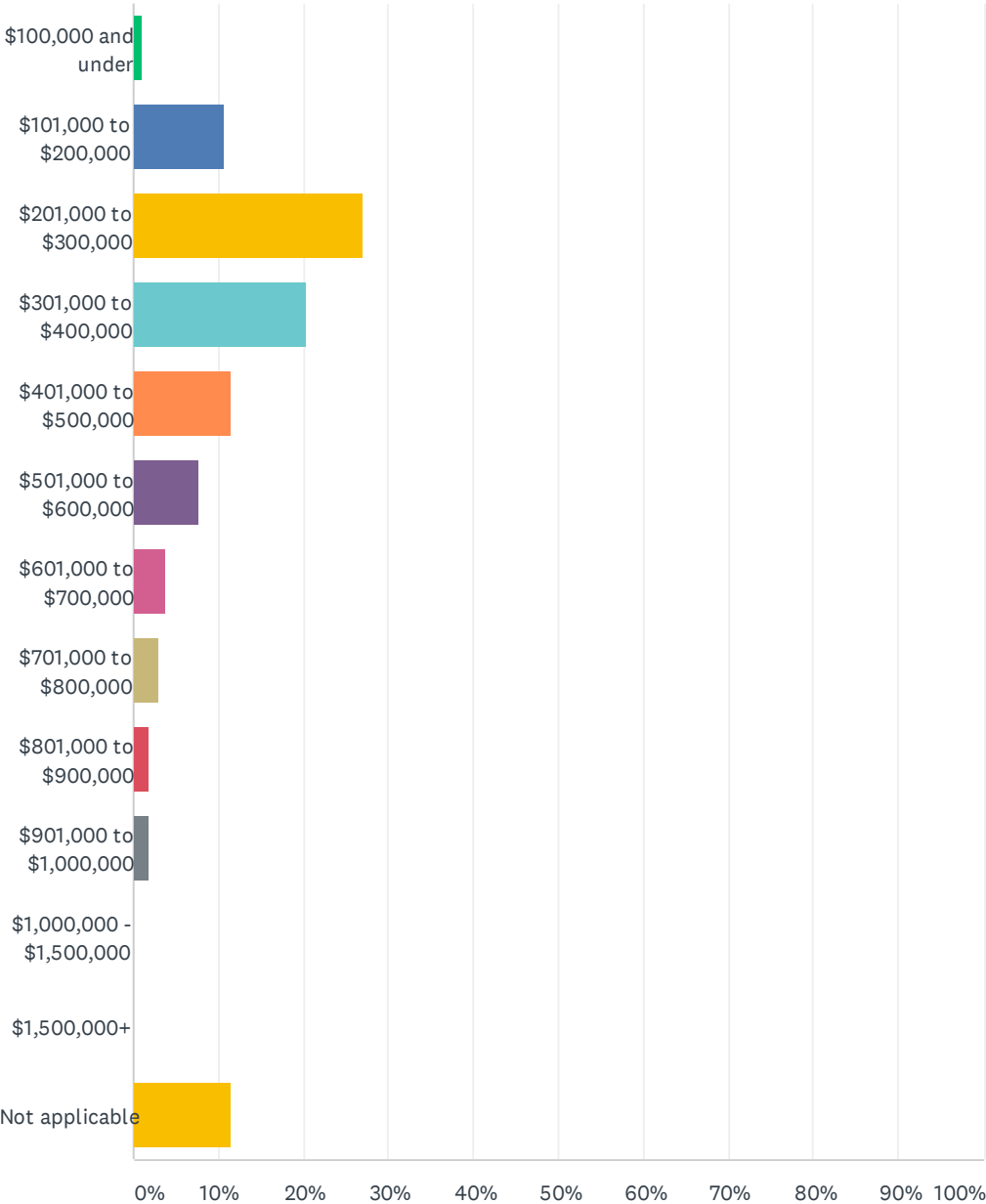

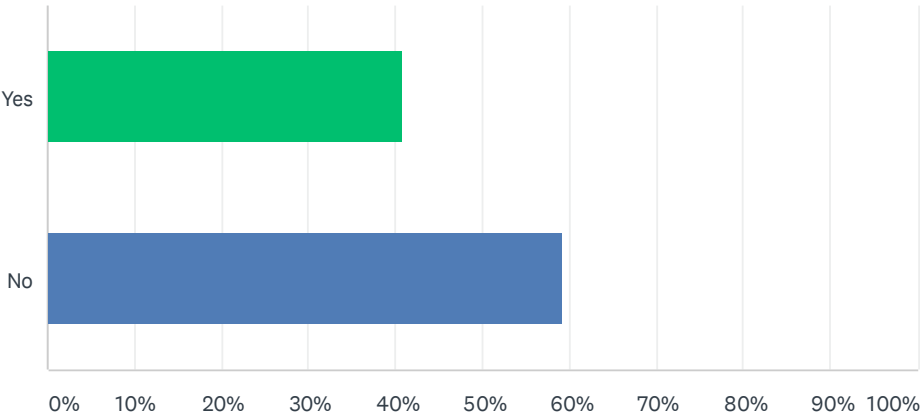

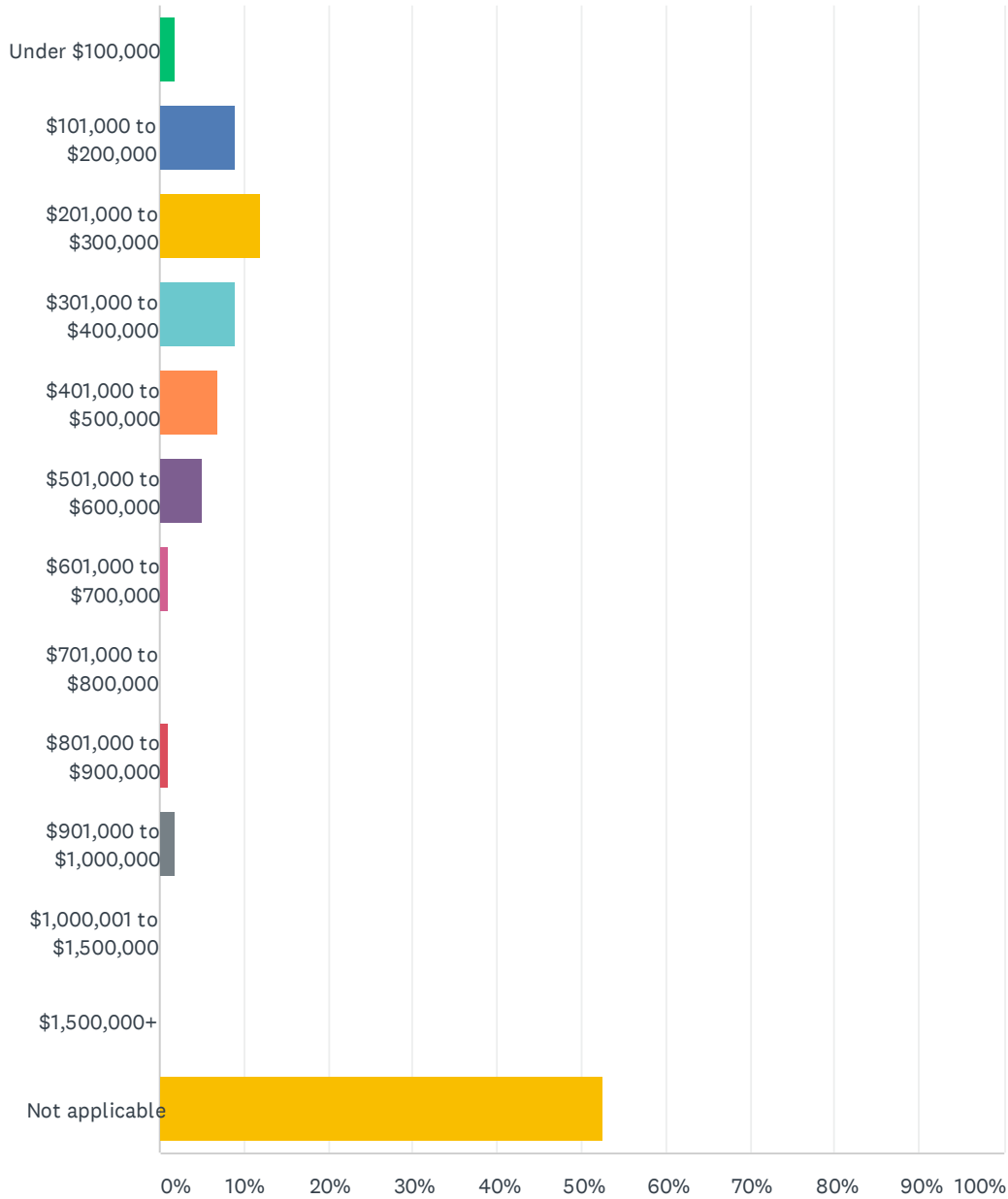

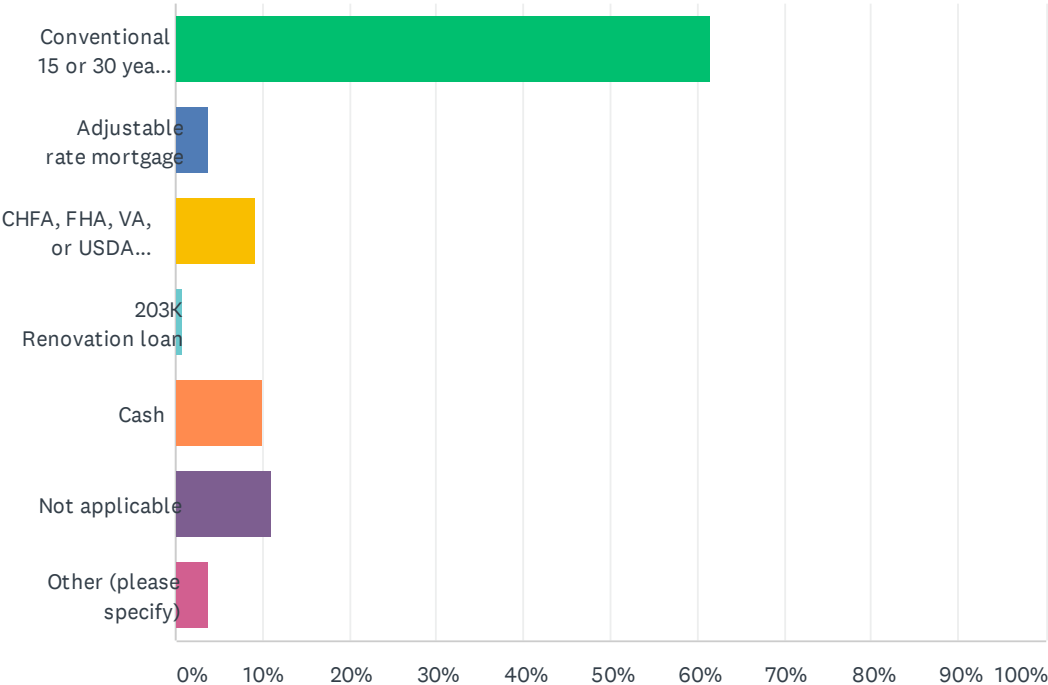

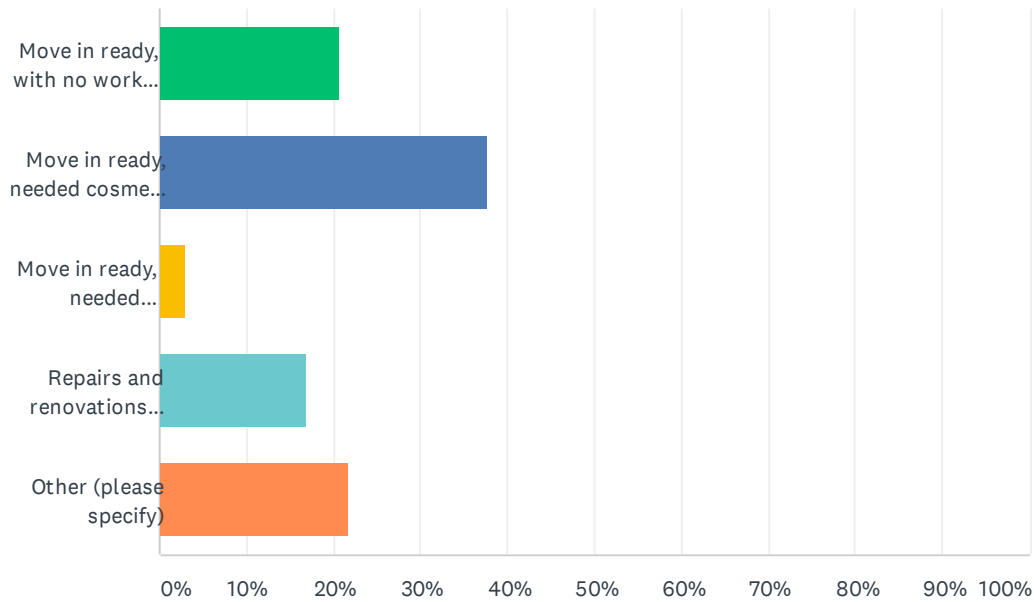

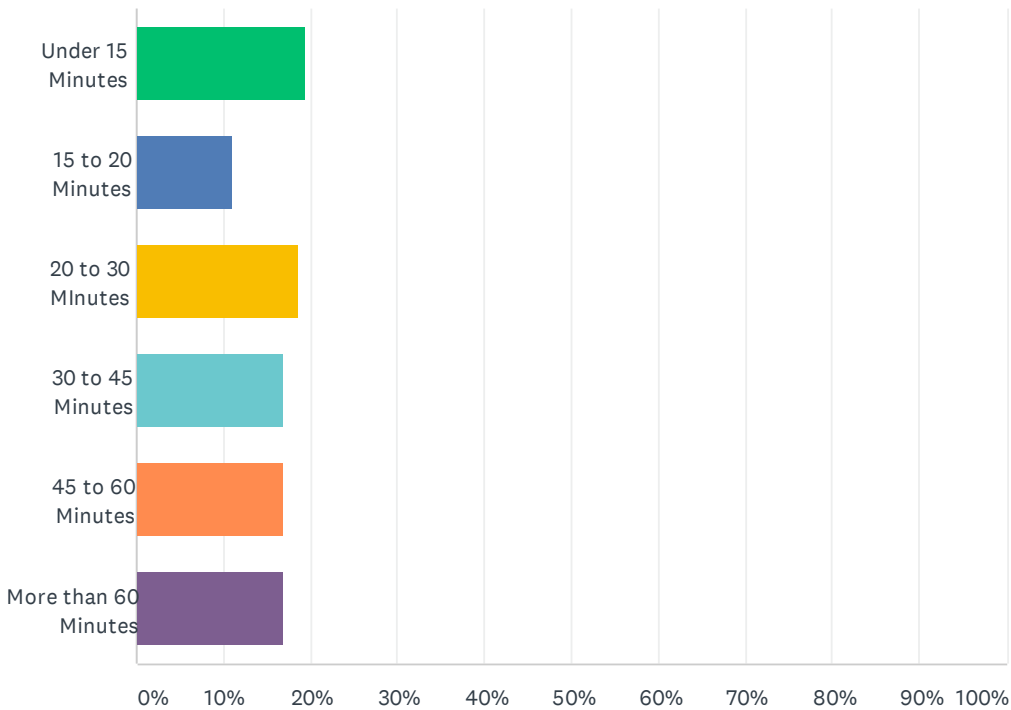

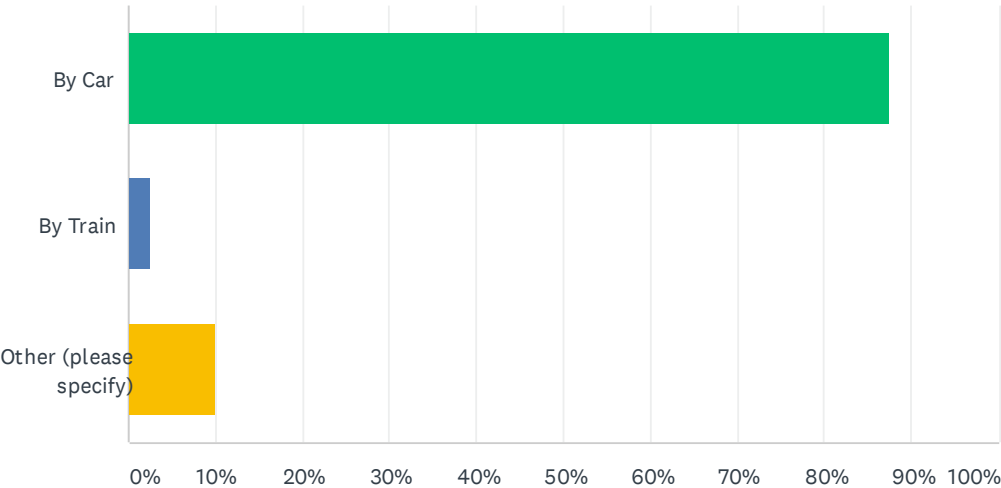
