Today I bring a bit of good news. Our confirmed number of COVID(19) cases has not changed since Monday; we remain at ten. Please keep a prayer and warm thought for these folks that they may make a speedy recovery.

I have reached out to all of our real estate professionals in an effort to address concerns of our visiting friends from New York. All have assured me that their clients are complying with our voluntary 14-day isolation. I have heard from many visitors wanting to utilize our grocery and prescription medication delivery program. Please treat these folks as we would any of our visitors to Washington. These people remain a part of our community.

I continue to meet twice weekly with our Emergency Services Management Team. All protocols remain in place, and the various services have done an incredible job in securing needed supplies, responding to emergency calls, and keeping open lines of communication. We owe a debt of gratitude to these dedicated, skilled individuals.

Concerns have been raised about several public areas throughout the town. We are monitoring crowds at Steep Rock, Hidden Valley, The River Walk, etc. Currently all remain open, but I will notify townspeople if there are any changes. Please remember, if you are using these venues, exercise safe distancing.
