As of this writing, we continue to have 10 confirmed COVID(19) cases in town. While no increase is good news, it is worth noting that we still must continue to adhere to all guidelines set forth by the CDC and the State of Connecticut.

Note: There will be no grocery deliveries Friday, April 10th. Please plan accordingly.

A few updates on public areas. With the large influx of visitors to town, we are trying to make sure our outdoor venues stay open to the public, but we need your help:

- Please try to utilize the various Steep Rock Parks at off-peak hours; before 10:00 A.M. and between the hours of 3:00 and 5:00 P.M.
- Until further notice, the children's play areas, basketball courts and tennis courts will remain closed at the Washington Primary School property.
- Great places to spend time in the outdoors are Macricostas Preserve, Hidden Valley, Steep Rock, and the River Walk trail at the Washington Primary School. Please, if you see one area is crowded, try one of the other parks.
- Please remember to think of others. If you are a town resident, feel free to offer help and guidance to those who may not be familiar with the area. If you are visiting from out of town, please remember to follow our rules and guidelines. They are in place for everyone's safety and enjoyment of the parks.
