Today's update will focus on the continued re-opening of Washington. Our Town Beach will be open beginning Saturday, June 20. Please observe and follow the protocols put in place. There will be a limited capacity at the beach to ensure social distancing. Attendants will be available to assist as needed. On Monday, June 22, Town Hall will be open to the public by appointment only. If you are experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms, please do not schedule an appointment.

Please continue to monitor Washingtonct.org and ExploreWashington.com to get the latest updates. Our long-term recovery committee has been busy reaching out to residents, businesses, schools, houses of worship and non-profits. Please reach out with any needs for yourself or someone you know. See below for complete Town Hall protocols.

- Call ahead to schedule an appointment with the department you will be visiting.
- Visitors will be met at the door by an attendant and directed to the proper office.
- Visitors must wear a mask while in the building.
- Please limit your visit to the time and department that you have scheduled.
- Staff will do their best to accommodate your desired time for an appointment, but there may be limited openings.
- There will be multiple hand sanitizer stations throughout the building.
- Entry and exit will be from the front door only.
- No appointments after 3:30. This allows staff time to sterilize the office.
