#### **Committee Reports/Updates:**

#### **Sustainability Committee:**

C. Matteo reported that the Equity Tool Kit that is required to obtain Silver Status from Sustainable CT is complete and will be submitted soon.

#### **Economic Development:**

M. Gorra reported that Washington is in the beginning phases of forming an Arts Council. Several residents have expressed interest in joining. The group is hoping to begin meeting in January of 2023.

#### **Broadband Committee:**

Chair Hileman informed the Commission that Woodbury, CT has put out an RFP for a feasibility study as well as a needs assessment regarding broadband.

## <u>Continued Discussion – 2023 Plan of Conservation and Development:</u>

C. Matteo, regarding an added update for the Sustainability Committee, informed the Commission that Sustainability has asked the Board of Finance for \$4,000 for community outreach and education. They were denied based on the determination that it was not an emergency, and were encouraged to add the amount in the next budget cycle.

Chair Hileman stated that the Planning Commission will begin the process of updating the Plan of Conservation and Development in January of 2023, and hopes to weave Sustainability throughout the entire plan.

#### **Communications:**

Response from Counsel re: Proposed Revisions to Subdivision Regulations:

The Commission received comments from legal counsel regarding the proposed revisions. The Commission reviewed the comments, with a few being misinterpreted by Counsel.

Chair Hileman stated that he will make the edits and corrections to the regulations, send the final version to S. White and she will then send them to the appropriate Counsel of Governments for their review, and from there a Public Hearing can be scheduled for approval.
