


Members of the Commission:

We are requesting a modification of existing permit IW-18-18, with approval date May 8, 2020, that among other items, includes: "renovate covered dock".

Due to the deteriorated and irreparable condition of the covered dock, it was not possible to renovate. A new dock and gangway, supplied by Regatta Dock Systems, and measuring 240 sq ft total, is proposed.

The proposed new dock, with similar dimensions to our contiguous neighbors, has a more pleasing appearance to the surrounding environment, and represents no diminished impact to the watercourses, and/or to the regulated area (site plan and enlarged drawing of new dock with dimensions are attached).

Construction of the dock, shed, bench, etc will occur as contractors and materials become available throughout the summer.
