Owner wishes to dredge to reach original depth. Red flags mark intended straight access road from Judea Cemetery Road. Secondary option was recommended over primary option; avoids septic mound in yard. Oak platforms will be utilized to drive equipment to pond. Red flags also delineate new pond edge. Remove Acer rubrum (Red, Swamp Maple) on south side of pond. Stone wall to remain on north side of pond. Concrete dam to remain on east side of pond. Southeast corner of pond, by concrete dam, will be used as dewatering area. Soil will then be used onsite around pond edge. Silt fence will be used behind concrete dam, in addition to other areas noted on plan.

Owner will remove Typha sp. (Cattail) currently within pond. Owner will remove all invasive plant species on south side of pond. Rosa multiflora (Multiflora Rose), Lugustrum ovalifolium (Privet), Rhamnus frangula (Glossy Buckthorn) Celastrus orbiculatus (Oriental Bittersweet) observed in area. Owner is to provide planting and maintenance plan for all disturbed areas. Native Ilex verticillata (Winterberry), Cornus sericea (Twig Dogwood), Lindera benzoin (Spicebush), Carex muskingumensis (Palm Sedge) present in area. Owner will also provide list of equipment to be used and construction sequence. Work is to commence in dry season (July, August; weather dependent).
