He has accumulated 34 roll off containers filled with garbage. Neighbors are complaining about an infestation of flies. The state is involved, the Attorney General's office and the DEEP. The state is going to court this Thursday, July 18th and are seeking a contempt order because he has not complied by removing the garbage. He has been burying garbage and coving it with horse manure. He has two separate parcels in Roxbury. Roxbury has also been dealing with him. We are not sure who is going to end up paying for the cleanup. All American is giving us an estimate of what it would cost to get the dumpsters out. The state requested to have the rubbish go to our transfer station but we are not sure what cost would be for the town.

Financial Reports: These are the June 30, 2019 balances but there will be more bills to come in that will be for last fiscal year

Education: Michael Croft will be the new vice principal at Shepaug.
