A call was made to the property manager at River Woods to see what the status of the money is for generator, have not heard back yet.

The Housing Trust still has not been given the money approved by the taxpayers. Apparently according to Liddy who attends NWC meetings the state has stopped all monies for a 2 year period for affordable housing. We are not certain if this affects The grant money for the Vincent Property which the Housing Trust was granted.
