Our team trains extensively and studies hard to be well prepared for emergencies. We stop what we are doing, day or night, to respond when you call 9-1-1.

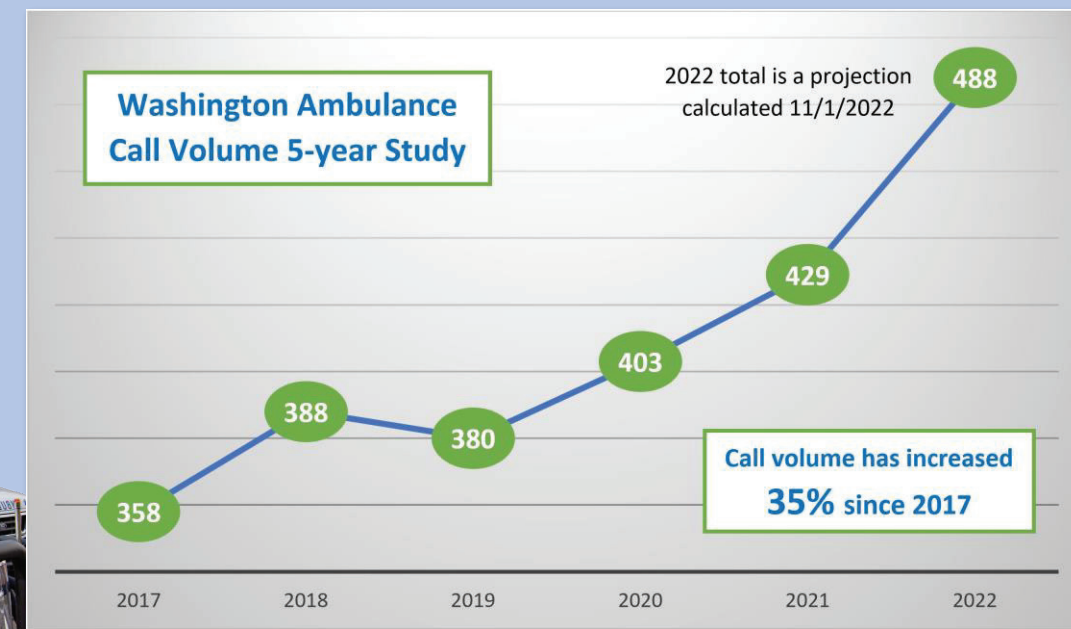
Ways to Support Our Team and Our Town:

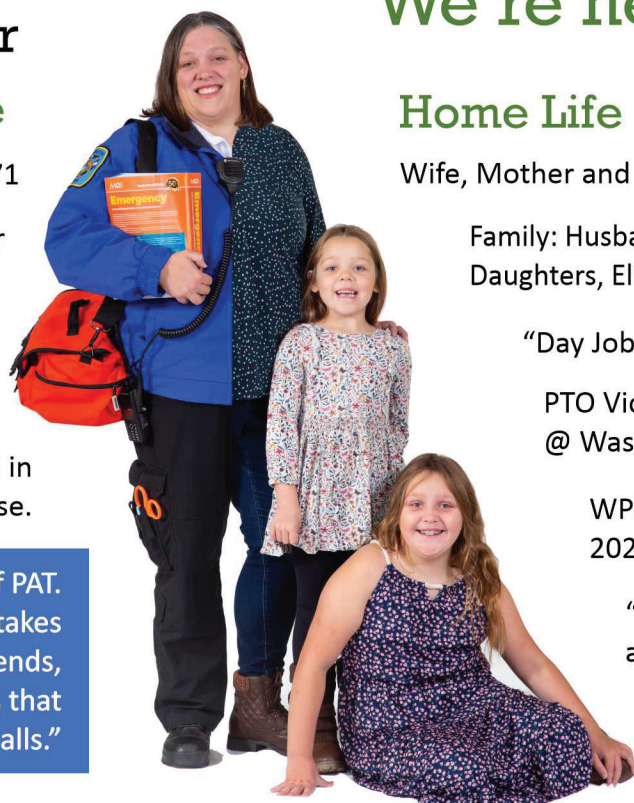

WASHINGTON AMBULANCE MAKES A HISTORIC MOVE

We are so excited to have moved a step closer to our new headquarters. Our crewmembers are currently meeting and training in the space at 92 Bee Brook Road. Although it is spacious and well-equipped, renovations will need to be done to accommodate the needs of a busy emergency ambulance service. We put a great deal of thought and research into our conceptual designs and the past 8 months of our "soft move-in" have proven very beneficial. Now we feel incredibly confident with our plans. This space will soon be renovated to suit the needs today as well as decades into the future. It will improve our capabilities and enhance our services to the community.

Renovations to include:

A three-bay structure for our emergency vehicles; a large training space with flexibility for crew training, EMT classes, and community CPR/First Aid classes; administrative offices; ample storage for medical and training supplies; crew lounge, sleeping quarters, kitchen, laundry, and private bathrooms with showers for members to be comfortable while on-call.

The funding of this project to date has been by private donations of \$1,154,221.00 plus funds from the American Rescue Plan Act. This mighty effort allowed the Town of Washington to purchase the building earlier this year for the use of the Washington Ambulance Association. The fund balance after the purchase will go towards the renovations expected to begin in the spring of 2023. We still need to raise more money to complete the project. We have events planned in 2023.

Please help us in honoring the generous donors to this project for the betterment of our Emergency Medical Services as well as the community.
